

PLEASE NOTE:

The National Weather Service, Flood Control District of Maricopa County, and Town of Fountain Hills will provide timely weather information and flood warning messages to you to the best of their ability using currently available technology. Be advised that prediction of flash floods is complex and conditions can change very rapidly.

You have a responsibility to do what you can to remain alert for changing flood conditions.

The impassable roadway crossings as indicated on this Emergency Access Map represents a worst-case scenario. Not all crossings will become impassable simultaneously, nor will they remain impassable for the same period of time. You may encounter a roadway crossing that is actually passable during a particular Flood Alert Level, but is indicated as impassable at that same Flood Alert Level on this map.

Follow the routes shown on this map to avoid having to backtrack and lose valuable emergency response time.

DO NOT cross barricaded roads! NEVER drive through flooded roadways, especially at night when dangers are harder to recognize. You may not know the depth or swiftness of the water or if the road surface underneath is still intact.
