








Wet and Cold antecedent Winter/Spring Seasons

NOAA/CPC 3-Month Outlook (JAS)







From Monsoon Outlook: 6/13/23

 Odds favor <u>Above Normal Temperatures</u> and <u>Below Normal Rainfall</u>; likely to see a later onset or even a false start; historical evidence supports more erratic placement of Monsoon Ridge; hopefully, a late season/fall push from El Niño. Not likely to have a repeat of 2021 or 2022.





Monsoon Moisture Tracker






Monsoon Ridge Seasonal Placement

July-August 1991-2020 Mean







Phoenix Summer Heat Stats:


- 21 Daily High Temperature Records Tied/Broken

- Total 110°F+ days, 54
- Total 115°F+ days, 17
- Total 90°F+ Lows, 33
- 31-day streak of 110°F+ Highs
- 16-day streak of 90°F+ Lows
- July Monthly Mean 102.7°F
 ✓ Hottest in Phoenix and any major US City
- Mean Daily Avg T Summer, 97.0°F
- All-Time Record Warm-Low Temperature, 97°F 7/19



Monsoon Lightning Tracker













June 15, 2023 - September 30, 2023 Monsoon Rainfall






June 15, 2023 - September 30, 2023 Monsoon Rainfall as Percent of Normal



Central AZ Accumulated Mean Monsoon Rainfall - Past 16 Years (297 Index Gages)





Monsoon Rainfall 2020 vs 2023 (Difference at ALERT Station +/-)



Average Summer Thunderstorm (Monsoon) Season Rainfall - Past 43 Years


Flood Control District of Maricopa County ALERT Rain Gages






Full Arizona Monsoon Summary

June-September 2023 Percent of 1981-2010 Normal




June-September 2023 Percentile


